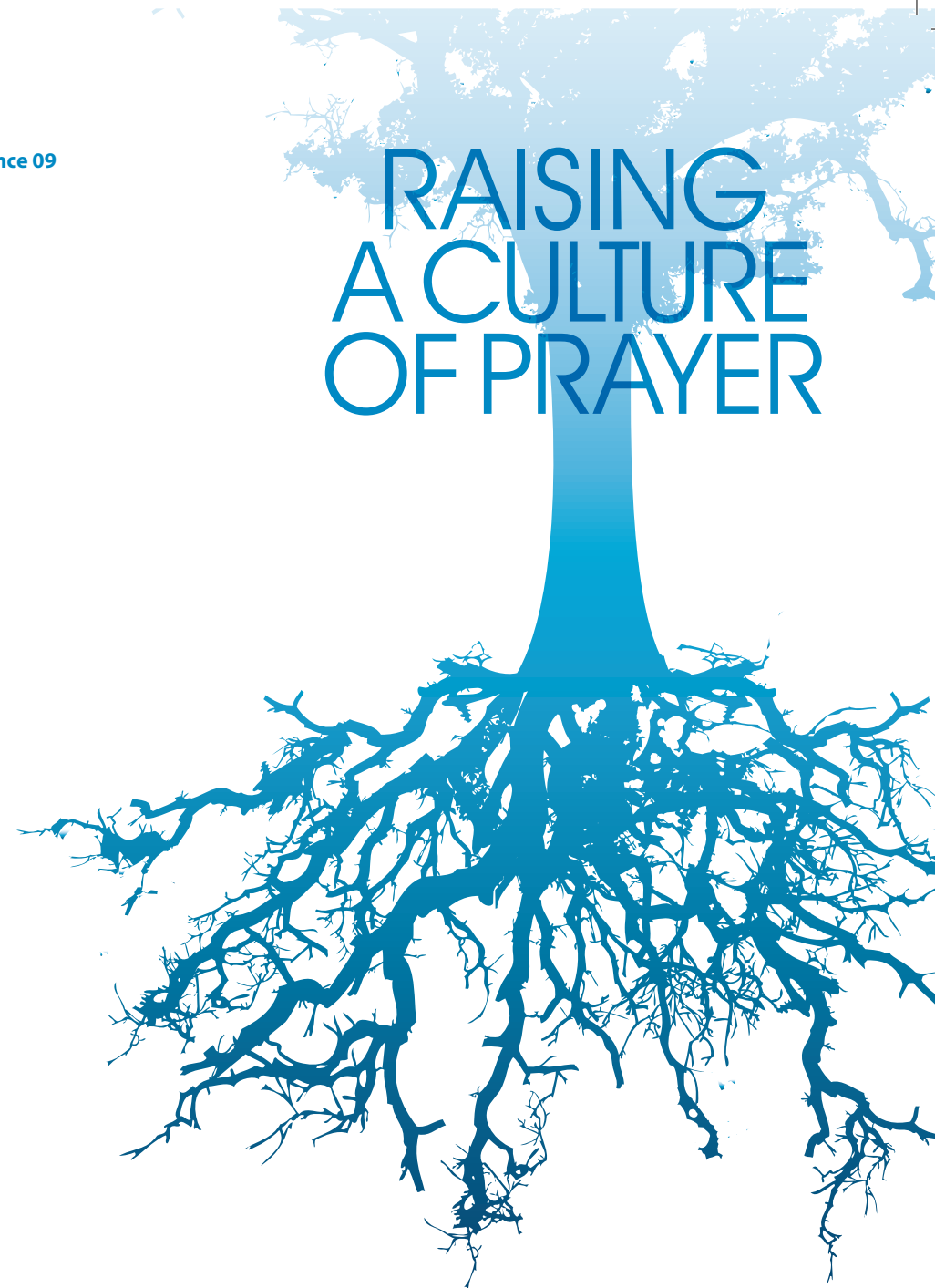

MIKE McCLUNG

Mike has strong prophetic gifting, and also a call and anointing to teach and exhort the Body of Christ. Mike's mission is to unveil the knowledge of God in order that transforming grace will be released to bring reformation to the Body of Christ and to rebuild, restore, and advance the Kingdom of God. Revelatory teaching on the Bride and Bridegroom paradigm, the Kingdom of God, as well as teaching that unlocks the beauty of the corporate nature of the Body of Christ, are at the heart of his ministry.

Mike is the senior pastor of Lionheart Fellowship and the Director of the IHOP-Knoxville Ministry Base, which is a ministry devoted to establishing night and day intercessory worship and prayer for the greater Knoxville region. Mike has also been involved in Native American reconciliation initiatives and forums, and Apostolic and Prophetic Summits both in the U.S. and abroad. His calling to intercede in order to "open up" ancient wells has led him to occasional travel and teaching both in the U.S. and overseas.

As Director of the World Prayer Centre vision in Birmingham, England, Ian has a passion to see prayer infiltrate into every area of local, national and international life. His work brings people together from across the denominations to worship and pray together and to see the Kingdom of God released at every level of society both in the UK and other nations. He passionately believes prayer changes things and that if Christians will humble themselves, call on God's name, repent and seek God's face, He will hear from Heaven and heal their land.

Ian has been involved in prayer at a global level praying at the United Nations, G8 Prayer Summits and other global institutions. He is also involved with the International Prayer Council and the Global Day of Prayer. The World Prayer Centre vision is to see a centre in Birmingham for 24/7 prayer. Ian has led a recent series of seven Trumpet Calls at the NEC Arena bringing thousands from around the UK to pray for our nations.
